This event is open to those who are seeking fun, adventure, discovery and making a friend or two while doing it.

We will be camping at all locations, so you'll need to bring your own tent, swag and bedding. We do have a truck to carry your sleeping gear to and from each location, but space is limited. We will announce a designated drop off point, just prior to the event, or you can hand over your items once on the run. You experience an array of camping venues, some with fine facilities, and others with no facilities, so be prepared. You will get to enjoy the friendship of nature, just as she had intended.

During the adventure, we'll organize all of your meals Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner, however you can bring what ever other snacks, beverages, and alcoholic drinks you require.

You'll get plenty of advanced notice before departure for you to prepare for little surprises that may pop up on the run, designed to challenge your team, or to add a fun element to the event.

We respect that the teams put a remarkable effort into fundraising, and we aim to support you in however or with ever you may need. Your membership login area is full of usefull tools, tips and functions to assist you on your fundraising journey. The site has pre-build links that you can share via social media, email and sms that will direct people to either your personal page, or your team page.

You will receive email newsletters, and sms messages updating you on what you need to plan for, pack, hints, tips, tricks updates and other bits of information that the organisers deem - worthy to know - so keep an eye out in your inbox. REGISTRATION GUIDE

- 1. Visit Our Website: Navigate to our official website https://www.sbrc.net.au/ and click on the 'Register' button.
- 2. **Team Formation:** Each car team consists of two people, "Team Captain" and the "Co-driver." The Team Captain must register first.
- 3. **Register as Team Captain:** During the registration process, you'll have the option to assign your Duster Team/Car name.
- 4. Fill in Details: Complete your personal information, and don't forget to acknowledge the terms, conditions, and waivers
- 5. Medical & Dietary Requirements: Make sure to list any medical and dietary needs.
- 6. **Payment:** The Team Captain will pay a fee of \$750 (\$600 + \$150 car registration fee). The Co-driver pays \$600. Upon successful payment, your personal/team page will be created.
- 7. **Welcome Email:** After successful registration, you'll receive a "You're IN!" welcome email. Your team page will be automatically set up. Keep an eye on your inbox throughout the year, as you will receive communications from the committee letting you know of run specifics and details.

ONCE REGISTERED

- 1. **Share and Compete** You can share your team page link or your individual link with potential sponsors. Create a friendly competition with your teammate or pool your efforts for team donations.
- 2. Offline Donations Received cash donations? Record it on your team page as an 'offline donation.' Check your toolbox, in your members area for more details on how to do this.
- 3. Earn badges as you complete tasks into your Team and Individual pages.
- 4. Personalise your message, update your bio and upload a pic of you and your car.
- 5. Send emails through your dashboard to sponsors, either create your own, or use one of the pre-made templates
- 6. Share to social media. Create your own posts, or feel free to use templates provided.
- 7. Create your own fundraising event within your dashboard, take ticket sales and assign them to your page.
- 8. Your Tool box in your dashboard has fundraising idea's to start you off
